

Northwest District Fall Camporee 2016

Extreme Scouting Games

October 7-9 Fred C. Andersen Scout Camp

Hosted by Troops 106 and 626

Event includes Obstacle Course with:

- Tire drag
- Ground crawl under ropes
- Tarzan rope swing
- A-frame barrier crossing
- Shoot the rapids (“boat” running on barrels placed by teammates)
- Net challenge
- Stretcher carry

Other Events:

- Paintball target course
- Biathlon with snowshoes and Nerf™ guns
- Water balloon launch and catch
- “Javelin” throw
- Life size arcade shoot (ball thrown through target carried by runner)
- “Chariot” race



Costs:

- \$15 per overnight camping Scout (Boy Scout or Webelos Scout)
- \$5 for overnighiting adults
- No charge for event staff but they must register
- \$6 for Webelos Scouts participating only for the day Saturday
- Food costs will be additional and managed by individual units as with a typical campout. If Webelos come only for Saturday they can arrange to lunch with partner Troop or bring their own lunch.

Who should attend?

- Boy Scouts of all ages
- 5th grade Webelos Scouts with a parent or designated adult for each Scout and 2-deep leadership for each Den/Patrol (at least one registered adult and second adult who is a registered leader or a parent of a participating Scout) may camp overnight with a partner Boy Scout Troop if prior arrangements are made with the Troop.
- 5th grade Webelos Scouts can participate for just the day on Saturday with 2-deep leadership for each Den/Patrol and no more than 4/1 Webelos Scouts/Adults.
